#### YOUR LIBRARY IS ON THE BALLOT

# On Nov. 18, the Livingston Parish Library's sole source of funding will be up for the vote!

On November 18, 2023, Livingston Parish voters will decide whether or not to extend an existing 10-year, 10-mill tax on acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining, and operating the Livingston Parish Library.

This is **A RENEWAL** of a parish-wide property tax that has been in place for 30 years: It was initially passed in 1995 and renewed in 2005 and 2014.

THIS IS NOT A NEW TAX.

#### **Key Facts**

The millage is the Livingston Parish Library's major revenue source, funding more than 99% of the system's annual operating budget. This crucial funding source generates \$6 million a year and covers nearly all costs associated with operating a library system that serves 120,000 patrons.

If the millage is renewed (a vote "YES"), it would go into effect in 2025 and run through 2034, meaning the Livingston Parish Library would be funded through 2035.

If the millage is not renewed (a vote "NO"), the Library could be unfunded by 2026.

The General Election will be Saturday, Nov. 18, 2023. Early voting runs Nov. 3-11.

#### **Community Meetings**

The Livingston Parish Library will host informational meetings to answer any questions the public may have regarding the 2023 millage renewal request.

The schedule for the upcoming meetings is as follows: South Branch: 5:30 - 6:30 PM on Thursday, November 2, 2023. Watson Branch: 5:30 - 6:30 PM on Monday, November 6, 2023. Main Branch: 5:00 - 6:00 PM on Tuesday, November 14, 2023.



#### **YOUR Library's Mission**

Since its establishment in 1946, the Livingston Parish Library has proven to be a well-managed steward of public funds with a mission to provide all members of the community with the resources and programs necessary to fulfill their informational, educational, recreational, and cultural needs. WE ARE A LIBRARY OF THE COMMUNITY, FOR THE COMMUNITY.

If the millage is renewed, the Library would be able to maintain and enhance its current services, programs, and events while also fulfilling a few long-term goals, such as building a sixth library branch, adding a Nature Trail behind the South Branch, buying a second mobile library, and hiring new staff.



## **GAME NIGHT**

Livingston Parish Library make board games available for check out



In its mission to fulfill all the needs of the community, the Livingston Parish Library has added board games to its collection of materials that patrons can check out.

The new collection provides access to board games in a variety of styles of play that inspire continued learning, constructive play, and critical thinking. Board games are available for players of all ages and skill levels.

Patrons will be able to check out board games starting **Nov. 1**. Adult, senior citizen, and educator patron types may check out two games per card for one week. Board games may be renewed once if there are no holds on the item.

The board game collection features games for preschoolers, elementary ages, tweens, teens, and families. It includes card, cooperative, party, educational, classic, and strategic games for various skill levels.

Patrons can stop by any of the five LPL branches to scan the games in person beginning Nov. 1, or they can search for Board Games in the Library's online catalog on that date. Games can be placed on hold and delivered to a patron's preferred branch.

Patrons are asked to return games with all pieces to the circulation desk at their nearest branch. **Board games may not be returned in the drop box.**


