## **Livingston Parish Library Cardholders Can Now Reserve State Park, Historic Site Passes**

It's time to explore Louisiana!

Through a new program, Livingston Parish Library cardholders can visit Louisiana's State Parks for free.

The program, called Check Out Louisiana State Parks, allows library patrons in participating parishes to check out a day pass to any state park or historic site at no cost.

The program is a partnership between the State Library of Louisiana and Louisiana State Parks. The Livingston Parish Library is one of 18 public library systems participating in the pilot program.

A limited number of park passes are available during the pilot phase of the program. In Livingston Parish, the park passes are included in our Cultural Passes and can be checked out by the following card types: Adult, Educator, and Senior Citizen.

The Check Out Louisiana State Parks program also includes a limited number of Geaux Explore backpacks that cardholders may check out.





These backpacks contain binoculars, a compass, magnifying glass, Leave No Trace outdoor ethics cards, and guides to Louisiana birds, wildlife, and trees and flowers. The Geaux Explore backpacks do not have to be checked out in order to reserve a park pass.




