# Livingston Parish Library to host 9th Annual Comic Con event Feb. 24

Are you ready for Livingston Parish's BIGGEST celebration of comic books, movies, television, video games, and all things pop culture?

We hope so... because we are!

One of the parish's most popular annual events will return when the Livingston Parish Library (LPL) hosts its 9th Annual Comic Con on Saturday, Feb. 24. People of all ages are invited to celebrate their favorite fandom at this free event, which is open to the public.

Comic Con will run from 10:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. at the Denham Springs-Walker Branch. All other branches of the Livingston Parish Library system will be closed the day of the event.



Inspired by the mega-event that takes place annually in San Diego, LPL's Comic Con invites attendees to participate in games and activities, interact with local authors, illustrators and graphic novelists, and dress up as their favorite characters from books, comic books, movies, television, video games, and more.



Held at the Livingston Parish Library's biggest, most innovative branch, visitors can also utilize the Library's Idea Lab, which contains virtual reality and 3D printing capabilities. In recent years, one of the most anticipated events has been the Cosplay Contest, which draws dozens of participants of all ages.

And one new addition we know visitors will love is the availability of food trucks. That's right — there will be food trucks at Comic Con this year!

## **SPREADING SOME HOLIDAY WARMTH**

LIBRARY COLLECTS 3,055 PAIRS OF SOCKS IN SOCK DRIVE

Once again, the Livingston Parish community showed its giving spirit.

Approximately 3,055 pairs of new, unused socks were donated through the Livingston Parish Library as part of Baton Rouge Parents Magazine's 19th Annual Sock It To Me! Sock Drive.

This is the most the system has ever collected.

Held every year during the holiday season, the Sock It to Me! Sock Drive takes place in the Greater Baton Rouge area, covering East Baton Rouge, Livingston, Ascension, Pointe Coupee, Iberville, and West Baton Rouge parishes.

To ensure donations remain in the Livingston Parish community, all socks collected by the Livingston Parish Library were donated to The Family Village, a Walker-based non-profit organization that serves Livingston Parish.

Founded in 2018, The Family Village provides necessities to children who have been separated from their homes in a traumatic event. The items are provided free of charge to children of all ages, ranging from newborns to teenagers and young adults.

On average, The Family Village serves more than one child per day.






### **VITA TAX PREPARATION**
