WHAT A YEAR!

2024 was a big year for the Livingston Parish Library, and we have much to celebrate!

Over the last year, YOUR Library continued in its mission to provide all members of the community with resources and programs to fulfill their informational, educational, recreational, and cultural needs.

Here are a few accomplishments and milestones from the last year:

- We held our biggest Comic Con to date, with more than 2,000 visitors.
- We held our biggest Summer Reading Program to date, recording the most-ever SRP registrations and completions as well as the highest SRP event attendance.
- The Denham Springs-Walker Branch was voted runner-up for "Favorite Library Branch" in Baton Rouge Parents Magazine's 2024 Family Favorites contest.
- We became one of 18 library systems to launch the Check Out Louisiana State Parks program, which allows cardholders to visit Louisiana's state parks and historic sites at no cost.
- We introduced a new program that gives adults a second chance at earning a high school diploma.
- We partnered with Keep Louisiana Beautiful and Keep Livingston Parish Beautiful to acquire Litter Kits that cardholders can check out.
- We partnered with Livingston Master Gardeners to introduce Seed Libraries at all five branches.
- We reported increases in physical and electronic circulations, as well as library visits.
- We launched a new online calendar system.
- · We introduced a new checkout item: Celebration Kits.
- We teamed with Mighty Moms, a Livingston Parish-based nonprofit food pantry, for its SOUPer September canned soup drive.
- We collected sock donations for The Family Village, a Livingston Parish-based non-profit organization, as part of the 20th Annual Sock It To Me! Sock Drive.


